Caring for and Safeguarding our Diverse Community

Our Aims:

1. Care for children, young people and vulnerable adults across the Diocese.
2. Ensure that all volunteers within the diocese are fit for purpose and their role, via appropriate safeguarding checks.
3. We will regularly train all active role holders within the Diocese- including Clergy, parish safeguarding representatives, staff, trustees, in their responsibilities in keeping people safe.
4. We will regularly review our working practices in line with national policies and guidance.

Our Promise to you:

1. The Policy of Safeguarding and Protecting people for Charities and Trustees (Gov UK 2017 updated 2019) **must** be followed at all times. There must be a clear set of procedures to be followed by the Diocese at each stage and a clear system of referral or reporting to the relevant organisation as soon as concerns are suspected or identified.
2. That **ALL** concerns are responded to quickly and appropriate investigations are undertaken.
3. At all stages a written record **WILL** be made and a course of action agreed by all parties which will be signed and dated. This **MUST** include an agreed and realistic timetable.
4. All parties will maintain contact in an agreed format and on designated dates and a record of conversations made and agreed.
